The Sustainable Retirement and Aged Care Conference 2015, held today at the Majestic Hotel on 22 October, was organised by Aged Care Group, an aged care service provider in Malaysia. The conference theme, #A Shared Synergy Towards an Integrated Ecosystem reflected the demographic shift towards a more affluent and health-conscious society. Over 320 participants from the financial service providers, insurance and investment companies, medical and healthcare providers, real estate agencies, aged care facility operators, legal experts and regulatory bodies attended the conference.

In his keynote speech, Fabian Bigar of PEMANDU spoke on how the pieces are coming together at the PEMANDUs Economic Transformation Programme for Senior Living initiative, citing that the Private Aged Healthcare Facilities & Services Bill will be ready for tabling in Parliament this year and that his team is currently working on the regulations for the Bill.

After that, the highly charged dialogues by experienced speakers explored relevant issues including the financial options for retirement in Malaysia, best practices from other developed countries, and the gaps that need to be addressed to meet the retirement needs of our rapidly aging society among others. 
